Rules for Exhibiting Artists

Section 1 – Event organizer The 2011 MIGS Art Gallery is organized by Alliance numérique and takes place at the Hilton Montreal Bonaventure on November 1st and 2nd, 2011.

Section 2 – Exhibition categories All artwork created by artists from the video game industry must fall within one of the following 4 categories: Character modeling (3D), Environment modeling (3D), Concept art: Characters (2D) **or** Concept art: Environment and props (2D)

Section 3 – Exhibiting artists Any highly skilled professional or amateur artist can submit a piece of artwork.

Section 4 – Number of artists and artwork pieces per artist The Art Gallery will accept a maximum of 50 artworks. The MIGS selection committee reserves the right to limit the number of artwork pieces per artist.

Section 5 – Insurance Artists must provide their own insurance. The organizers are not responsible for any damages to the artwork that may occur during the entire exhibit, including the hanging and removal of the artwork.

Section 6 – Agreement to the Rules All participants of the exhibition must agree with the present Exhibit Rules.

Section 7 – Cancellations due to fortuitous events Alliance numérique reserves the right to change the program content and schedule or any other aspect related to the event. In case of cancellation, the responsibility of Alliance numérique is limited to the refund of prepaid fees for displaying at the Hilton Montreal Bonaventure, if applicable.

Section 8 – Exhibit Rules

8.1 – Application All applying artists or companies must abide by the Exhibit Rules. Applications must be received before the deadline of October 15th, 2011. Applications must contain the following documents:

- A final version of the artwork
- A completed Application Form
- Payment

8.2 – Eligible artwork The Art Gallery only accepts original artwork. Reproductions or photos published in magazines, postcards or other printed and viewable formats will not be accepted. The organizers of the exhibit reserve the right to refuse any artwork they believe has been copied from another artist or reproduced in a way which infringes copyright. Furthermore, Alliance numérique and/or the Hilton Montreal Bonaventure reserve the right to refuse any artwork they consider to be indecent, pornographic, racist, too violent or otherwise unacceptable topic.

8.3 – Exhibition space Exhibition spaces will be assigned by Alliance numérique. Any modifications or changes to the exhibition space are not allowed. The artist must abide by the specific exhibition space assigned to him/her and respect the spaces assigned to the other artists. As soon as an application has been approved, an exhibition space will be reserved under the name of the artist. It is not necessary for the artist to be present when the installation of the artwork will be carried out by the organizers. It is strictly forbidden to pierce the walls or modify their structure.

8.4 – Installation Installation will be carried out by Alliance numérique. Alliance numérique does not provide any equipment other than lighting, hanging systems and electricity (if they are already available in the exhibition space). If the artist damages any of the provided equipment, he/she will pay the costs.

8.5 – Opening All pieces of artwork must be installed before 9PM on October 31th, 2011, and removed between 6:30 PM and 9 PM on November 2nd, 2011.

Section 9 – Advertisement Photos sent with the application may be used for advertising purposes. Photos of the artwork and artists taken by the official MIGS photographer will only be used for advertising purposes to represent the event.

Section 10 – Removal and closure The Art Gallery will close at 6:30 PM, on November 2nd, 2011.
